David Robbins, native of Gastonia, N. C., began coaching basketball at Virginia Union University (VUU) in 1978. During his thirty-year career, he led the Panther Basketball teams to 713 wins – 194 losses with three NCAA Division II National Championships (1980, 1992, 2005). His teams won fourteen CIAA Championships and garnered twenty-one NCAA Tournament appearances. During his tenure at VUU, Coach Robbins produced four Division II Players of the Year, eight Consensus First Team All-Americans, and five NBA players (Ben Wallace, Charles Oakley, Terry Davis, A. J. English, and Jamie Waller). Coach Robbins is a member of the Catawba College, Virginia Union University, CIAA, Thomas Jefferson High School, and Gaston County, N. C. Halls of Fame. Coach Robbins officially retired on April 15, 2008 as Head Basketball Coach of Virginia Union University. In 2010, Coach Robbins was inducted into the Virginia Sports Hall of Fame and Museum. In 2012, Coach Robbins was elected to the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame. Most recently, he was inducted into the Small College Basketball Hall of Fame in 2017.
